Dear Newport Beach Resident or Business:

The Orange County Sanitation District (OCSD) would like to take this opportunity to provide you with information that may be of interest to you.

Construction will soon begin on Bayside Drive between El Paseo Drive and Carnation Avenue in the City of Newport Beach. Construction is scheduled for January 2010 with completion in late April 2010.

The job consists of rehabilitating the Bayside Drive trunk sewer and a small City sewer that connects to the trunk line. Both sewers will be fixed at the same time to minimize impacts to the community. By rehabilitating the sewers we will extend the service life and eliminate the need for replacement in the near future.

Due to the narrowness of the street, traffic control will be installed to provide adequate work space. The eastbound lane will remain open to traffic; however, westbound traffic will be rerouted as indicated in the enclosed fact sheet. Parking along the north side of Bayside Drive between El Paseo Drive and Carnation Avenue will also be restricted.

OCSD understands that construction around the neighborhood can impact those who live here, and we understand that you may have questions or concerns about the construction. **We kindly invite all interested parties to attend a Community Meeting on Thursday, December 3 at 6:30 p.m.** at the **Sheriff's Harbor Patrol Office located at 1901 Bayside Drive, Newport Beach, CA 92660**. OCSD staff will be on hand to provide further details about the project and answer any questions you may have.

OCSD is committed to ensuring that all construction is conducted in accordance with City ordinances. Every effort will be made to minimize vibration, dust and noise impacts during construction. Work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; evening work hours will be required for a portion of the work, however, notifications will be distributed as we approach that date.
